The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC), in accordance with the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 and subsequent amendment thereto had accorded Environmental Clearance (EC) to M/s Jayaswal Neco Industries for Gare IV/4 Coal Mine Project (1 MTPA of which 0.4 MTPA OC and 0.6 MTPA UG) in ML area of 701.512 ha located in Tehsil Gharghoda (now Tehsil – Tamnar), Dist. Raigarh, Chhattisgarh subject to compliance of terms and conditions stipulated in the EC letter No. J-11015/183/2010-IA.II (M) dated March 12, 2013.

WHEREAS the Supreme Court of India vide judgment dated 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 read with its order dated 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 has cancelled the allocation of 204 coal blocks and issued directions with regard to such coal blocks wherein the Central Government in pursuance of the said directions has to take immediate action to implement the said order.
